
Art Supply List

Class: Watercolor

Instructor: Thomas Needham

Please Note: *We strongly suggest that you make certain your class will go forward before purchasing materials.* The Gertrude Herbert cannot reimburse students for the cost of personal supplies in the event that a class must be cancelled.

Materials & Cost: Total cost of materials will vary depending on what you already have, but expect to spend \$50 to \$130 by the end of the course. Much of it is a one-time cost of getting started (e.g., brushes, palette).

Brushes: 1" and 1/4" flat (watercolor brush with beveled handle)
7, 5, 3, and 00 round (watercolor brushes, sable brushes)

Paint: Be sure to get transparent watercolor, not gouache or designer's colors

Yellow Ochre	Ultramarine Blue
Naples Yellow	Cerulean Blue
Raw Sienna	Sap Green
Burnt Sienna	Burnt Umber
Cadmium Orange	Designer's Gouache (white)
Cadmium Red	
Alizarin Crimson	

Optional: Cobalt Blue, Payne's Gray, Davy's Gray, Hooker's Green, Mauve, Cadmium Yellow

Paper: One 20" x 30" sheet
Watercolor paper or watercolor board is very much a matter of personal choice. Pick a watercolor sheet or board you are comfortable with. I recommend using Crescent Watercolor Board no. 5112. This is an acid-free board with a very white surface that is 100% rag. This board can be cheaply purchased at www.aswexpress.com for \$10.50 per 20" x 30" sheet.

Misc. Water container (motel ice bucket size)
Palette (butcher's tray or old white plate, porcelain or plastic)
#2H pencil
Kneaded eraser
Small kitchen sponge
Rag (old hand towel or t-shirt)
Masking liquid ((Art Masking Fluid or Maskoid), old "cheapie" brushes, rubber cement pick-up, piece of soap, cup)
3/4" masking tape
X-acto knife
Half dozen Q-tips
Toothbrush
Something to haul your stuff around in—a tool/tackle box or tote bag
