### **Basic Drawing Tools:**

*[Anything with an \* in front of it is optional]*

- Graphite drawing pencils --- #2 or HB (regular), #2B (medium soft), #4B (soft), #6B (extra soft) – GENERAL brand is adequate. *[For those more serious about brand names: Derwent, Faber-Castell 9000, or Staedtler Mars Lumograph are excellent brands]*
- Kneaded eraser
- \*Art vinyl or plastic eraser
- \*Small pencil sharpener
- Blending stump or tortillion
- Sketch pad (less expensive paper for exercises & experimentation) 14 x 17 or 16 x20 are good sizes
- Drawing pad (White, heavier weight: 60 – 80#) – 14 X 17 or 16 x 20 good sizes
- \*Drawing backboard for more stability [In-class backboards are provided]

### **Additional Intermediate Materials: (For Drawing With Various Techniques)**

*[Anything with an \* in front of it is optional]*

- Vine or willow charcoal sticks (medium)
- Charcoal drawing pencils --- HB (regular), #2B (medium), #4B (soft), #6B (extra soft) *[Ritmo, Royal, or General are good brands.]*
- Conte crayons or pencils - (White, Sanguine brown, Venetian Red, Sepia)
- Charcoal paper - 14x17 or 16x20 good sizes
- \*Tinted paper such as Mi-teintes or pastel paper - 11x14 to 14x17 good sizes
- \*Charcoal powder
- \*White Bristol Board (fairly expensive) or illustration board
