Basic Drawing Tools:

- Graphite drawing pencils --- #HB, #2B, #4B, #6B
(Derwent or General are good brands)
- Charcoal drawing pencils --- #HB, #2B, #4B, #6B
(Ritmo or General are good brands)
- Kneaded eraser
- Sketch pad (newsprint or other less expensive paper for exercises & experimentation) 14 x 17 or 16 x 20 are good sizes
- Drawing tablet (White, heavier weight: 60 – 80#) – 14 X 17 or 16 x 20 good sizes
- Photographs of head & shoulders to work from

Optional, More Intermediate Materials:

- Blending stump or tortillion
- Vine or compressed charcoal sticks
- Conte Crayons or pencils - (Sanguine brown, Venetian Red, Sepia, White)
- Tinted paper such as Mi-teintes or pastel paper
- White Bristol Board (fairly expensive) or illustration board
- Drawing backboard for more stability
