Watercolors: tubes colors,

Gamboge (yellow)	Cobalt blue
Cadmium Yellow, light	Ultramarine blue
Grumbacker red or any true red	Phthalo Blue
Cadmium. Red, light	Viridian
Permanent rose	Black
Raw sienna	Burnt Sienna

I use Quinacridone colors when I have a chose... ex. Quinacridone Gold instead of raw sienna. This is a good beginner list . You may have more colors on your palette that is fine. We need at least these colors. If you are a beginner, student grade paint such as Cotman, Grumback Academy, or Van Gogh will be fine, if you are more advanced I recommend professional grade paint such as Da Vinci, Winsor& Newton, Holbien, or Daniel Smith.

Paper: Lana 140 weight or Arches 140 – No student grade, please! You may buy sheets 22x30 and cut into 11x15 or buy pads or blocks in that general size you will need a **support board larger** than paper and **tape and/or Bulldog Clips**

Brushes: Synthetic Brushes or fine, you are looking for your Rounds to hold a point when wet (and any other brushes you have)
Round, #8 and #12 approximant size, larger is better!
Flat, 1 inch

Palette: plastic large with cover
Paper towels
Sketchbook
Pencil
Kneaded Eraser
Water containers – 2 - large
