Art Supply List

Materials & Cost: Total cost of materials will vary depending on what you already have, but expect to spend \$50 to \$130 by the end of the course. Much of it is a one-time cost of getting started (e.g., brushes, palette).

Brushes:	1" and $\frac{1}{4}$ " flat (watercolor brush with beveled handle) 7, 5, 3, and 00 round (watercolor brushes, sable brushes)		
Paint:	Be sure to get transparent watercolor, not gouache or designer's colors

Paper:	One 20" x 30" sheet Watercolor paper or watercolor board is very much a matter of personal choice. Pick a watercolor sheet or board you are comfortable with. I recommend using Crescent Watercolor Board no. 5112. This is an acid-free board with a very white surface that is 100% rag. This board can be cheaply purchased at www.aswexpress.com for \$10.50 per 20" x 30" sheet.
